

This Ministry in March, 2013 under National Clean Energy Fund (NCEF) and NRDWP funding had sanctioned 10,000 units of Solar Based Dual Pumping Systems for drinking water supply schemes for 82 IAP Districts. Subsequently, 20,000 units were sanctioned in collaboration with Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) and NRWDP funding (October, 2014) for various States. These schemes are to be implemented as per the guidelines hosted on the Ministry's web-site. The experiences gained so far shows that solar energy has excellent potential to energize drinking water supply schemes, particularly, in remote and IAP/LWE areas.

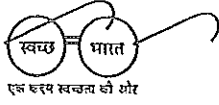


