Dear Sir / Madam,

This is in continuation to my earlier letter of even no. dated 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016. You are aware that the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation is going to launch National Sub-Mission on Arsenic and Fluoride very shortly. Under this Programme, funds will be provided to States ring fenced only to the population affected with arsenic or fluoride.

2. The Ministry has created a link called "National Water Quality Sub-Mission" on MDWS website which will capture data of Line estimates / DPR. The **Username** and **Password** for opening this link is same which is given to the **IMIS Coordinators** of the districts. You are requested to direct concerned officials to prepare Line estimates quickly for new schemes wherever DPRs are not available and the data of which can be entered into the web link. Wherever DPRs are available for new schemes, the data of the same is also to be entered into the Sub-Mission web link. **For ongoing schemes on arsenic and fluoride, the Sub-Mission web link will be established by the NIC (National Informatics Centre) Wing of the Ministry.**

4. Your personal intervention is requested to direct all the concerned officials to make data entries latest by 18<sup>th</sup> November 2016.
