Dear Madam/Sir,

During Annual Action Plan (AAP) meeting held from Feb-2017 to April-2017 with all the States / UTs wherein the progress achieved under different components of NRDWP was reviewed and target for 2017-18 was set and it was emphasized that all States should get their assets geo-tagged at the earliest and update the same on Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Ministry. I would like to draw your attention towards this Ministry's letters dated 30.07.2016, 03.03.2017 and 27.03.2017 regarding geo-tagging of all assets of rural water supply schemes.

2. It has been observed that only few States (viz. Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Tamil Nadu) have shown the intent to do the geo-tagging of their assets of rural water supply schemes by making fair progress in this regard. However, most of the States have shown nil / poor progress in this regard.

3. It is pertinent to mention here that the status of progress made with respect to geo-tagging of assets is being reviewed by very high level in Government of India on daily basis.


4. As such, all States are hereby directed to beef up the process of geo-tagging of their assets at the earliest as well as update the same on IMIS. The states which have made good progress are also requested to saturate by completing the said work.

5. It has come to notice that some States have geo-tagged their assets with IMIS source IDs which can be integrated with IMIS. Such states may provide data to NIC for necessary action in this regard and peruse the matter.

6. If States have geo-tagged their rural water supply assets with different Ids i.e. other than IMIS source IDs, then they must map with IMIS source Ids first and then provide the data to NIC for necessary action.
