

Minutes of the Video Conference held on 24.08.2017 from 1:00 PM to 2:30 PM under the chair of Shri Dinesh Chand, Addl. Advisor with State's IMIS co-ordinator regarding provision of IMIS format for making entries for flexi fund uploaded in Ministry's website.

List of Participants from the Ministry as well as from States is at Annexure:

- 1) Director (Water) has deliberated the flexi fund provisions stipulated under NRDWP guidelines to the states and reiterated that States can use Flexi fund to the extent of 25% of the total funds released to them under NRDWP for taking up works for mitigating the drinking water scarcity / natural calamity in an area as per the instructions issued by this Ministry as well as MoF time to time in this regard.
- 2) States have been directed to carry out 'a test case' by transferring Rs. 1 from one component to another as flexi fund and send its report through email at yogesh.kmr@nic.in along with the queries, if any on working of this system.
- 3) States have also been asked to contact over telephone to NIC officials of this Ministry for any doubt with respect to making entries for flexi fund in stipulated IMIS format.
- 4) Director (Water) has also assured to make provision of generating report regarding flexi fund entries on IMIS.(Action: NIC, MDWS)
- 5) Nodal officer / IMIS Co-ordinators have been directed to brief their Engineer-in-Chief / Chief Engineer / In-charge (RWS) and to convene a video conference with district level field officer (SE/EE/JE) to make them aware of the provisions of flexi fund and its entries into IMIS.
- 6) It was stressed that in this process, the NRDWP guidelines should strictly be followed.
