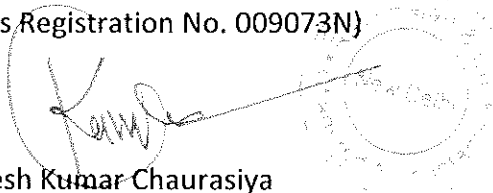

1. 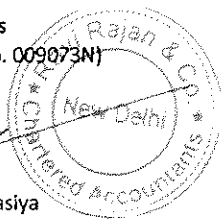

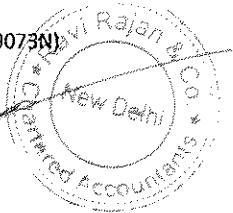

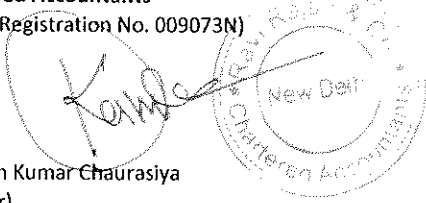
