

## Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation

**Minutes of the Video Conference held on 07.12.2017 from 09.30 AM to 10:30 AM under the chairmanship of Secretary(DWS) with the Principal Secretaries / Secretaries/ E-n-Cs / Chief Engineer of rural water supply in the States / UTs regarding submission of claims for release of second instalment under normal component (reimbursement mode).**

List of Participants from the Ministry as well as from States is at Annexure:

- 1) Secretary (DWS) mentioned that the Ministry is considering requesting competent authority for extension of timeline for submission of claims by the States / UTs for release of second instalment under normal component (reimbursement mode) from 30.11.2017 to 31.12.2017.
- 2) Secretary (DWS) has further mentioned that in case the proposal for extension is approved, the States / UTs will now get sufficient time to get funds from their Finance Department, to incur expenditure and resubmit the proposal for submission of claims for release of second instalment under normal component (reimbursement mode) by 31.12.2017.
- 3) Joint Secretary (Water) stated that as present checklist, format D-21 is showing that expenditure made on the scheme of NRDWP and other than NRDWP, the same has been revised to show expenditure on NRDWP schemes only which is being launched by the Ministry. Accordingly, States / UTs may verify D-21 and incur required expenditure. The States / UTs which have already sent the proposals to this Ministry are also requested to see the revised format D-21 and re-submit the proposals, if required.
- 4) JS (Water) also directed the States to co-ordinate with NIC team of this Ministry to resolve IMIS related issues under intimation to water division of the Ministry.
- 5) States viz. UP, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Haryana have expressed their inability to submit the claims for release of second instalment under normal component (reimbursement mode) even after extension of deadline as they are unlikely to get the fund from their Finance Departments.
- 6) States have also been asked to contact over telephone to NIC officials of this Ministry, Director (Water) and concerned Area Officer for any clarification in this respect.
