Subject: Removal of duplicate beneficiary names in Format ER-01 of IMIS- regarding

Madam/Sir,

Please refer to my earlier two D.O. letters No.S-11011/3/2015-SBM dated 7th October, 2016 and 22nd November, 2016 on the above subject. It has been observed that in spite of repeated instructions from this Ministry for removal of duplicate beneficiary names from the SBM-G website, States/UTs have not been able to complete the exercise till date.

2. It has been now decided that the list of probable duplicate beneficiary names as shown in Format No. ER-01 (List of probable duplicate beneficiaries), will henceforth be removed from the SBM-G website and will no longer be visible in any of the online reports from May 1, 2017. These records will be stored separately and can be viewed by the authorized States/UTs user after logging into IMIS.

3. The States/UTs Government can consider these records for deletion /re-entry into the system after necessary verification is done. The States are requested to devise compulsory protocol to include these beneficiary names into the live SBM-G database, which will be considered on case by case basis, if need arises. However, the responsibility of considering these beneficiaries as eligible for incentive under SBM-G will rest completely with the respective State Government.
